- Env-17-46 **NOTICE OF MEETING:**  
The notice of convening the meeting was taken as read
- Env-17-47 **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:**  
Apologies were received from Cllr Tina Large
- Env-17-48 **CODE OF CONDUCT:**

- Env-17-49. **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:**  
There were no members of the public present
- Env-17-50 **MINUTES OF LAST MEETING: FIO**  
Minutes of the last meeting were resolved at the Annual Meeting
- Env-17-51. **PLANT A TREE CHARTER LEGACY TREE:**  
A discussion took place about registering and gathering more information about the Plant a Tree Charter Tree project.  
**It was resolved** that Thornaby Town Council would register for more information.
- Env-17-52 **LANDSCAPING ON MILLBANK LANE/GLAISDALE RD/BAYSDALE AVE:**  
Members attended a site meeting with concerns about cars, motorbikes cutting across the field at Baysdale Road, trees have been damaged. Trees at Millbank Lane/Wheeldale Crescent are more robust. Members felt that 30 more trees were required near the Fire Station, Millbank Lane, these would cost approximately £250 per tree. Consultation had taken place with SBC and 10 trees might be funded by them. More detailed costings to be obtained from SBC before a decision is made.
- Env-17-53 **ALWAYS ADVANCING:**  
NC (SBC) would provide the bark. Another idea was to plant wild flowers around the roundabout to hide the wall, at a cost of approximately £500.  
It was resolved that that once the detailed costings are available work would proceed.

Env-17-54 **DIBBLE'S BRIDGE:**  
Discussion has taken place on how to ensure that the people are never forgotten and ideas have been discussed with Derek Smith a writer and film maker. These were:

- An exhibition of 30 x A1 panels with a timeline of Thornaby's history.
- A 10-15 film will accompany the exhibition based on interviews and visual information gathered.
- A 50 page, A5 publication with print run

The total cost would be approximately £15000 including the research with costs split over 2 years.  
Contacts have also been made with L.S., a well-respected sculptor and artist, who was first on the scene at the disaster with the possibility of commissioning him to produce a memorial. To be discussed at Full Council for decision.

An approximate cost of £500 per lamp has been obtained. RG to meet with IH (SBC) on 20/6/17 for more detailed costs.


Env-17-57 **FAITH EVENT:**
