- ESP-19-19 **NOTICE OF MEETING:**

- ESP-19-20 **APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE:**

- ESP-19-21 **CODE OF CONDUCT:**

- ESP-19-22 **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:**
There were no members of the public present.
- ESP-19-23 **MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:**
It was resolved and agreed that the minutes dated 17th June 2019 were a true and accurate record.
- ESP-19-24 **ROLL OF WHEELIE BINS:**
One hundred and fifteen bins were rolled out in the pilot area of Heslop Street, Langley Avenue and the east side of Mansfield Avenue, south of Cobden Street at no cost. Blue boxes and recycling bags to be delivered later in the week. Consultation on Alley Gates continues with only CFYA and Enforcement from SBC having keys to them. Concerns were raised about health and safety, TTC will provide full support until health and safety concerns are finalised.
- ESP-19-25 **BULB PLANTING:**
Thirteen are planting thousands of bulbs in the area. Concerns about the bulb planting have been raised by CFYA, SBC that the bulbs should remain on land owned by Thirteen. **It was agreed** that Ward Councillors to check their areas to ensure that the bulbs are on Thirteen land.
- ESP-19-26 **CLEANER TOWN FOR ALL:**
Cllr Luke Frost is to launch a pilot scheme to make our town a cleaner place for all and increase the participation in recycling which would initially involve three schools in Thornaby. The scheme would cost approximately £1460. Councillors agreed that the scheme could possibly roll out to all schools in the area. Cllr Luke Frost to provide a more detailed breakdown of costs for further discussion at the next meeting..
- ESP-19-27 **NEW WASTE BIN OUTSIDE McCOLL'S NEWSAGENT, NEWTON DRIVE:**
The waste bin outside McColls on Newton Drive needs replacing as it is beyond repair. JE to contact JA, SBC to obtain a quote for a new bin which will cost approximately £1000. **It was agreed** that the bin should be replaced.
