- EX-23-08 **PLANNING:**
- to confirm that the SBC lists for Applications and Delegated decisions have been circulated by email and to discuss any concerns.
- It was agreed and confirmed** that the SBC lists for Applications and Delegated lists have circulated by email.
- EX-23-09 **THORNAFEST UPDATE:** for decision  
Cllr Glenn Eastick provided the following update:
- ticket prices
- Tickets to be priced at £15 per person, family £40, children under 12 to go free.
- Bookings
- Acts to perform are The Sequel, Manchester Anthems, Fleetwood Mac Tribute Band and Murray Mint.
- wristbands & banners
- Wristbands will cost approximately £500 and the banners at a cost of £650.  
**It was agreed** that the costs for the Thornafest event be accepted.
- EX-23-10 **TOWN HALL ROOM RENTAL:** for decision  
Discussion took place about the renting the rooms in the Town Hall. An intercom system was required for each rental room so that each business would be able to deal with customers directly. Rooms to be rented out from £150 to £300 per month.  
**It was agreed** that contracts are to be drawn up and that an intercom be installed for each rental room at an approximate cost of £4,000.
- EX-23-11 **KING CHARLES III CORONATION:** for decision  
**It was agreed** that a session of Face Painting and Crafts for children would be provided by TTC at the Town Hall between 10.30 – 14.30 on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> May at a cost of £400.  
This is in addition to grants of up to £500 for Care Homes in Thornaby.
- EX-23-12 **THORNABY SHOW:** for decision
- tents
- Discussion took place about the tents for Thornaby Show as the company who provided in previous years is not available for the show in 2023.  
**It was agreed** that a new company could provide four tents, two x 36' x 54', one at 27' x 27' and one at 72' x 36' at a cost of £6,200 plus vat.
- food vans
- It was agreed** that food vans would be allowed at the show again at the same pitch fee as last year.
- EX-23-13 **PLAQUE FOR GEORGE & PHYLLIS SHORT:** for decision  
TTC had been approached about a plaque for George and Phyllis Short who resided at Terrace and who led an anti-fascist campaign in the area.  
**It was agreed** a plaque could not be installed as permission would need to be obtained from SBC but that an article could be placed the Thornaby Pride instead.
- EX-23-14 **POLICING IN THORNABY:** for discussion  
Cllr Steve Walmsley voiced his concerns about the policing in Thornaby as bikes were ridden on paths, and dangerous driving. Response times need to be improved and a letter sent to the Chief Constable about the bad behaviour of youths in Thornaby. A letter from Cllr Walmsley be sent to the gazette.
- EX-23-15 **CLERKS REPORT:** The Clerk will provide a verbal update on issues and correspondence arising since the last meeting.  
The installation of the RAF plaque is scheduled for May 19<sup>th</sup> at 1pm.
